Title of Vocational Educational Program:

Freight forwarding.

Qualification to be Awarded in Georgian and English:

Secondary Vocational Qualification in Freight forwarding.

Programme aims:

The aim of the vocational educational program is to prepare competitive personnel for the field of freight transportation, who will be able to fill out transport documentation; plan freight transportation; describe types of transport and select the appropriate type of transport; work in a team; supervise, monitor and evaluate transportation; place an order; organize loading/unloading of cargo and perform assigned duties in compliance with professional ethics, labor and safety standards. In addition, graduates will be equipped with professional and general/transferable skills.

Admission Prerequisites:

- Complete general education.

Employment Field and Opportunities:

Freight forwarding and transport and logistics companies, customs and transport service companies, transport and logistics associations, trade and logistics complexes of various levels, trade purchasing and intermediary companies, large distribution companies of finished products, distribution and logistics centers, customs terminal complexes, intermediary companies.

Structure and Modules:

The vocational education standard includes 3 general modules, with a total of 9 credits, and 7 vocational modules with a total of 81 credits. To be awarded a qualification, a person must accumulate at least 90 credits, and the duration of study is 20 months.

Description of Qualification/Learning Outcomes:

The graduate can:

- Describe the organizational structure and operations of a freight forwarding company;
- Describe the legislation and regulations related to freight forwarding;
- Plan transport and forwarding activities;
- Prepare the documentation necessary for the implementation of transport and forwarding activities;
- Carry out transport and forwarding activities;
- Control the transportation of cargo;
- Control the quality of transport and forwarding activities.

Awarding Qualification:

To obtain a vocational qualification, a vocational student must accumulate credits from modules specified in the vocational education program.

Location of Vocational Program Implementation:

The program will be implemented at the Railway Transport College, JSC "Georgian Railways" and JSC "Goodwill".
